Take the Superstition Freeway (I-60) east to exit 191 (Ellsworth Avenue). Turn right on Ellsworth driving approximately 1/2 mile, past the police & fire station. Turn right on Grand Avenue, entering Las Palmas Grand Resort. Announce yourself to the guard. Continue on Grand Avenue to the clubhouse area. Circle the clubhouse and park where you can. The main entrance is on the west.

When coming from the North or South use the Loop 202 and exit East on Guadalupe Rd. Travel approximately 1/2 mile East to Ellsworth Rd. and turn left (North). Proceed to entrance of resort on left and follow remainder of instructions above.
