Take I-10 east to US-60 East. Travel east on US-60 about 40 miles to Florence Junction and AZ-79. Exit on to 79 heading south. Drive about 13 miles. As you cross over the Arizona Central Canal you will see a mobile home residential area on the right. This is Florence Gardens. About 3/4 mile past the canal turn right on Gila Blvd. (a very short blvd.) into Florence Gardens. At the stop sign turn right on to Florence Blvd. and continue until you see the golf course on the right. On the left is the Florence Gardens Club House. This is where most events will be held. If the events are at a different area, you will be given additional directions.
